

Print out this checklist and pop it into your makeup cabinet. Keep a pen/pencil nearby and whenever you buy a new product, update your checklist with the appropriate dates.

Most makeup should be discarded either before, or by, three years post-purchase. Why? Because expiry dates are just as valid on makeup as they are on food. Ever heard the old adage of 'don't put on your skin what you wouldn't eat'?

Bacterial contamination can lead to infection, but if you're like me, opening up your makeup drawer doesn't suddenly remind you of the exact dates you bought everything! Hence this checklist, ensuring that you discard of products once they're past their safe dates.

Also – remember:

- Don't share makeup
- Don't add water (or anything else!) to dilute
- Don't keep in direct sunlight
- If mould is evident throw it out instantaneously!
- If there is a colour or texture change again throw it out now!!
